
Today we are celebrating World Book Day, by dressing as our favourite book character. There are some incredible costumes and lots of creative ideas. Well done everyone!

Parking

We have received a number of complaints about parking and driving on Baldwin Webb Avenue this week. Please do not block driveways when you park, however quick you will be. Please do not stop in the road to let people get out.



We know that there is more traffic on Baldwin Webb Avenue while the Church Walk entrance is closed.

We really encourage anyone who can walk to do this, and if you must drive then consider parking a little further away from school and walking the last part of your journey.

The yellow zig-zag markings at all 3 entrances are designed to keep everyone safe. Please do not park on the yellow zigzags (this include taxis).

Parking Enforcement Officers have already visited and will be coming regularly over coming months.

Please do not drive onto the school site unless you have a blue disabled badge.
