Class 6 - 92.38%

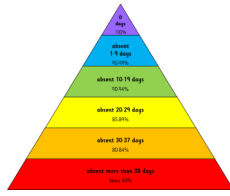


Early Bird = Class 6

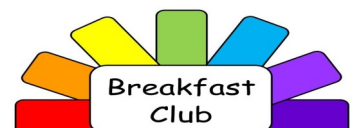

- ♦ provide water to drink regularly throughout the day
- ♦ keep children out of the sun (indoors)
- ♦ keep school and nursery as cool as possible
- ♦ offer calm activities instead of PE or physical play

Please make sure your child has a sun hat in school / nursery every day. Sun cream can be applied at home before children come into school / nursery although in extreme heat the children will not go outside to play.
