2,206 posties were injured by dogs in the past year.

That's **42** attacks each week, with some suffering life changing injuries.

- If your dog is running loose outdoors on your premises your mail can be suspended

Water Bottles

Children do not need to bring water bottles to school or nursery to use in class.

We provide individual, named cups, which are washed daily, for all children. Water (and cups) are also available for all children in the hall at lunchtime. School Food Standards state that children should only be drinking water when in school. If your child has a different drink for lunchtime please send it in a named bottle. This should be a small bottle ideally no bigger than 500ml. Please do not send large bottles or fizzy / sugary / sweet drinks for lunchtime.

Please make sure all your child's school uniform, coat, shoes and PE kit is labelled with their name
